## Come Join Us In The Fun!

One of the things about being in the art glass world that we enjoy the most around here is getting to share in the satisfaction and enjoyment we see our students and customers experience as they learn new skills, create new designs and spend time doing something they love. It really brings people together, creating in us, a common bond. Lately in several of our classes, we've had couples, best friends, sisters, and mother/daughter teams coming to take classes together. We do our best to offer a wide selection of opportunities for you to join in the fun, no matter if you are a beginner or advanced, have lots of time or little.

We have a couple more Saturday classes coming up in the next few weeks. On August 9, we will be having the much asked for Dangle Bracelet Class. This is an advanced level jewelry making class, and if you have taken our Beaded Earring Class you have the experience required to take this class. Most of our Saturday classes last about two hours, but this one is more involved, so we have set aside four hours for this class. We will be teaching how to wrap wire and add jump

rings which hold the sparking "dangles." We will be using sterling silver for all the findings, and will have several different colors of beads for you to choose from. If you like to make jewelry, you won't want to miss this class.

We will continue to further explore the realm of wearable art on August 23 in our Wire Wrapped Pendant class. Using cabochons made here at the shop, we will show you how to turn these simple fused glass pieces into a fabulous piece of jewelry.

Coming up in September, we will be offering our Lead Came Construction Class. This is another four week session that we only offer twice a year. This is the traditional method of making stained glass, used for centuries mostly in cathedrals and aristocratic homes. After the pieces of class are cut, they are inserted in to lead channels which holds them in place. It gives a very different look from the copper foil method which we teach in our regular beginning classes. This method requires different techniques and a few different tools. If you enjoy the copper foil

method and want to take your skills to the next level, you are sure to enjoy this class.

Since it's just around the corner, we are starting to think about what Saturday classes put in the Fall offerings. We have a few ideas, and several of you have made requests and suggestions. If there is something you would like to learn how to do, let us know and we will try to get it on the schedule.

### **Dangle Bracelet Class**

In this advanced level jewelry making class, we will combine the skills our students learned in our Beaded Earring Class and our Beaded Bracelet Class to make a Dangle Bracelet. It's a charming piece with lots of movement that is sure to catch the eye.

We provide the supplies and using your choice of beads we will walk you through designing, sizing and assembling a bracelet in the class. All of the supplies to make one bracelet are included in the class fee. A tool kit is also required and is not included. Tool kits will be available, and can be purchased on the day of the class if you need one. We will also have additional beads and supplies available for purchase if you would like to make more bracelets at home.
