### Soldering Skills Workshop

In this hands-on workshop, our in-house soldering expert will lead you through the ins and outs of soldering basics and beyond. Find out how different types of solder and copper foil, flux, soldering irons and temperature controls impact the look and feel of your soldering.

An overview of basic soldering techniques will be covered in the class, along with one-on-one guidance to help you fabricate the best soldering possible. If soldering gives you trouble or if it's less than what you'd like it to be, then this class is for you.

When signing up for class please pick up the pattern that needs to be cut, ground and foiled prior to class. Bring to class your homasote board, morton layout blocks, soldering supplies and equipment. Prior experience is recommended.
