Mosaic Picture Frame Class

Join us for this fun hands-on workshop and learn to make a mosaic using the grout method. Use our butterfly design or create your own.

You will need to have your butterflies (or other design such as the flower in the picture on the right) cut out and ground prior to class. Bring some coordinating glass along to fill in the background. Also bring to class your glass cutting equipment, a small disposable bowl for mixing the grout, a bucket for water and a small sponge. You will need to purchase glue and grout at class.

Beginning Stained Glass

This is our entry level stained glass class. Over the course of four weeks, you will learn the techniques required to complete a small stained glass panel using the copper foil method. You will choose from seven previously selected patterns, and using the glass of your choice you will complete as small stained glass panel. The class fee includes instruction and the use of some of our tools. Supply kit (required) is \$59.49 plus the cost of the glass of your choice. This class is a prerequisite for many of our other classes.
