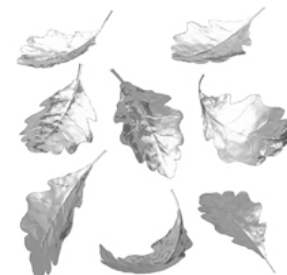

Hot Frit Workshop

Get ready for an afternoon of pure fun and learn how to add unique flair to your fused glass projects with Hot Frit. We will show you how to use a powdered frit mixture to "paint" your own designs onto the System 96 glass of your choice.

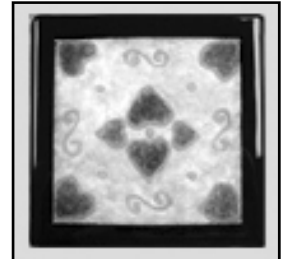
We will have several colors of glass and frit to work with so be prepared to let your imagination run wild and create your own design or use one of ours. The techniques you will learn in this class can be adapted to most any other fused glass project you have in mind. Please bring to class a small artist brush, tweezers, exacto knife, glass cutter and pliers. The size of the design needs to fit into a 4" X 4" area if you want to bring your own design

Prior experience is not required.

The Art of Decorative Soldering

Let us show you how to enhance almost any stained glass project using decorative soldering techniques. You can kick your creativity up to the next level by adding bumps, brambles, bamboo and many other effects that help add exquisite details to your projects. Find out how different types of solder and copper foil, flux, soldering irons and temperature controls can help you add a touch of drama and make your projects even more beautiful. An overview of basic soldering techniques will also be covered in the class, so if your soldering is less than what you'd like it to be, then this class is for you.

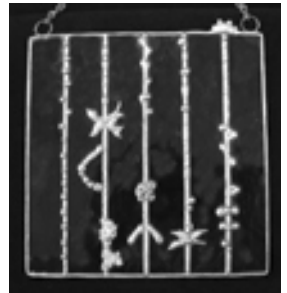
There is some home work that needs to be done prior to class. You need to have six strips of glass already foiled that are 1" wide by 6" long. Bring these with you on class day along with your soldering supplies and equipment

Beginning Stained Glass

This is our entry level stained glass class. Over the course of four weeks, you will learn the techniques required to complete a small stained glass panel using the copper foil method. You will choose from seven previously selected patterns, and using the glass of your choice you will complete as small stained glass panel. The class fee includes instruction and the use of some of our tools. Supply kit (required) is \$59.49 plus the cost of the glass of your choice. This class is a prerequisite for many of our other classes.
