In this class we will be featuring many shortcuts that can really speed up all your projects. Later in the month, we will be making Mystical Mini-Panels. These are delightful little panels that are fun, and easy to make, yet have a WOW factor that is amazing.

Also in September, we will be having our Lead Came Construction class. We only offer this class twice a year. This is the traditional method of stained glass

### Lead Came Construction

Have you been wanting to learn the Lead Came method? This four-week class teaches the basics of lead came construction. You will learn all you need to know to create your own leaded panels: pattern preparation and layout; choosing, cutting and soldering lead; and finishing a panel.

This class is only offered twice a year and space is limited so sign up early. Your pattern must be

construction and is very different from the copper foil method. You can take your skills to a whole new level as you learn the ins and outs of this method.

In October, we will be offering a new fusing class. We will be making little frames that you can make into a magnet or hang up with wire fused right into the glass. This is a new class for us, so be sure to read all the details below. We just got a new Kokomo pony crate. There are some out of

pre-selected and approved prior to the class. Tools and materials are extra and are not included in the class fee. You will receive a tools and materials list upon receipt of your class fee.

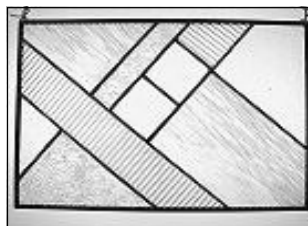
If you are comfortable with the copper foil method of construction and would like to take your skills to the next level, then this class is for you!

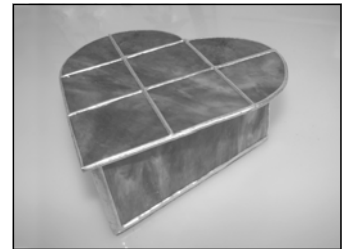
## Check Out Our Upcoming Saturday Classes

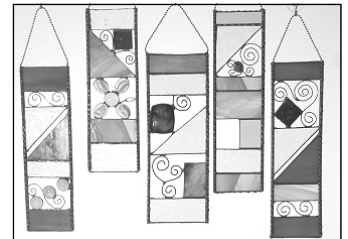

### Mystical Mini-Panels

Join us for this fun and relaxing 3 hour workshop where the toughest decision is which color combination to use. Bring your favorite pieces of scrap glass, a few jewels, bevels, nuggets, cabochons or whatever you like and we will show you how to incorporate them into a mystical mini-panel.

We will supply enough zinc U channel, wire and chain to complete one panel in class. Please bring to class your favorite scrap glass, nuggets or other accents, copper foil, glass cutting and soldering equipment and supplies, and needle-nose or chain-nose pliers. *Prior experience is required.*

### Beginning Stained Glass
