There's Always Something New to Learn

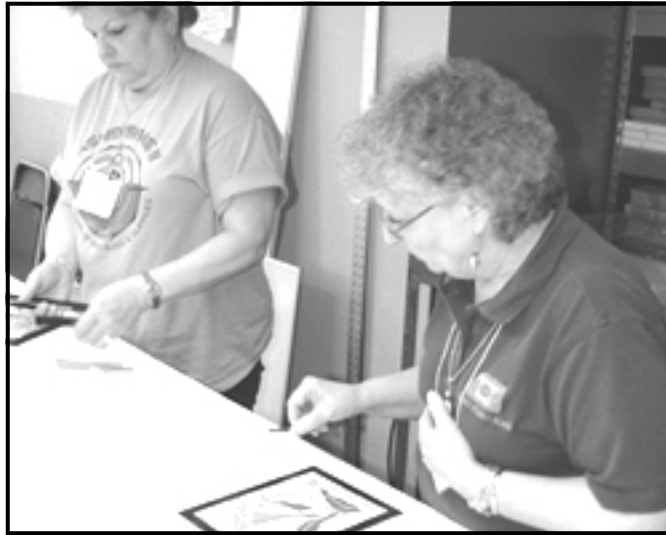
Dear Friends,

Lead Came Construction

Have you been wanting to learn the Lead Came method? This four-week class teaches the basics of lead came construction. You will learn all you need to know to create your own leaded panels: pattern preparation and layout; choosing, cutting and soldering lead; and finishing a panel.

This class is only offered twice a year and space is limited so sign up early. Your pattern must be pre-selected and approved prior to the class. Tools and materials are extra and are not included in the class fee. You will receive a tools and materials list upon receipt of your class fee. Prior glass experience is required

Check Out Our Upcoming Saturday Classes Dragonfly Suncatcher

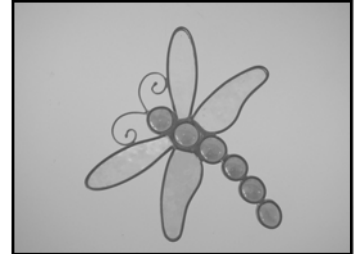

Beginning Stained Glass

This is our entry level stained glass class. Over the course of four weeks, you will learn the techniques required to complete a small stained glass panel using the copper foil method. You will choose from seven previously selected patterns, and using the glass of your choice you will complete as small stained glass panel. The class fee includes instruction and the use of some of our tools. Supply kit (required) is \$62.00 plus the cost of the glass of your choice. This class is a prerequisite for many of our other classes.
